The Downers Grove Community Advocates and other citizens filed objections to the "Strong Mayor" and "Retain Managerial Form" petitions with the court.

"We are pleased that the "Strong Mayor" question will not be on the ballot in April," said Stephen Daniels, Downers Grove Community Advocates president. "The community will now have the opportunity to fully discuss the form and function of our village government. We agree with Mayor Krajewski that withdrawal was in the best interest of the community."

The Downers Grove Community Advocates plans to hold a forum for the candidates in the April 5 election. DGCA, a group of community leaders, will continue to encourage public debate on important community issues.
